## NOTIFICATION UNDER THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (TREE PRESERVATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 – PART 3

Further to your notification received on 13th September 2023, I am able to confirm that the trees are of a condition to fulfil the description of being dangerous for the purposes of Regulation 14 (1) (c) of the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012. This exemption allows you to carry out such works as are urgently necessary to remove an immediate risk of serious harm without further notification to, or consent from, this authority.

I would be grateful if you could email <u>planning@testvalley.gov.uk</u> when you know the date of the proposed felling.

The legislation places a duty upon landowners to plant replacement trees for those removed under this exemption.

Therefore, I would be grateful if you could confirm that you will be planting another tree, which should be Sycamore (Acer pseudoplantanus) or Oak (Quercus robur) or Beech (Fagus sylvatica) and planted close to the stump of the original tree unless otherwise agreed in writing with this Authority. The replacement trees should be planted at the time of felling/loss or during the first planting season (November to April) following the felling.
