
I can confirm we are just applying for the change in balcony. The rest of the extension is complete awaiting sign off (final internal fixtures outstanding). The South elevation has not changed from the original plans and therefore these can be used. As explained previously, the height and width have not altered, it is only the depth of the balcony which is detailed on the west elevation. The east elevation will show the same picture but I will send anyway.

I was informed that putting in a new planning application was the easiest option over making an amendment to the existing plans however, this does not seem to be the case. Please advise if you feel this needs to be altered.
