Description of Proposed Works

Please describe the proposed development:

The proposed development is the installation of 315 no' 425W solar PV panels onto the existing roofs. The panels will be fixed to the roofs via a low profile mounting system. The 133.875 kWp system is expected to generate in the region of 120,000 kWh/year which is estimated to offset 16.9 tonnes of CO2 annually. Oxford City Council, which is the planning authority where the site is situated, have declared a climate emergency and the proposed installation will provide a positive step forward in helping to reach their targets. The installation is larger than 50kW and so no longer considered as microgeneration, however all permitted development rights have been adhered to when designing the system and as such as Prior Approval is being sought.
