Thank you for the email below and the feedback which I have addressed and re-submitted the application as Version 3.

Amendments to the submission include:-

- Correction to frame colour references, all of which (existing timber and proposed replacements) now refer to cream. Any reference to yellow removed.

- With reference to the supplied photo and it appearing white, I have added text to confirm the colour as cream but seemingly bleached via the sun.

- Replaced manufacturers brochure which hopefully better represents the flush casement windows proposed in this application. I've also added a Residence 9 case study with exterior colour cream wood grain effect, internal colour white wood grain effect as a best example of the windows proposed. Note: existing timber windows do not have Georgian bars, the proposed replacements will not have Georgian bars.
