Proposal: T1 - Remove small Sycamore tree which is growing too close to tree T2 and blocking light. See attached picture A1_T1.jpg
T2 - Lift canopy of Sycamore tree to allow more light into garden. Branches to be removed are shown in picture A2_T2.jpg
T3 - Remove small Laburnum that is growing at an angle into Church Lane and obstructing larger vans and trucks. See picture A3_T3.jpg
T4, T5, and T6 - reduce crown on northern side of Yew trees by 1.5m to allow light onto lawn. See picture A4_T456.jpg
