













- 01  Large format paving slabs
- 02  Stone shingle driveway on castellated ground grid
- 03  External polished concrete
- 04  Timber post and rail fence
- 05  Hornbeam hedging
- 06  Species-rich native hedgerow:
Blackthorn
Dog rose
Holly
Hazel
Hawthorn
or similar mix
- 07  Grass / lawn
- 08  Bin and cycle store
Feather edge cladding painted black
Max height 2.5m
- 09  Closeboard fence
- 10  A variety of plants with different heights, flowering times and growth habits.
Plant native plants suited to the clay soil conditions.
Planted in clusters of 3s and 5s throughout the herbaceous border on each side of the garden. To include:
Foxgloves (*Digitalis* spp)
Hellebores (*Helleborus* spp) - early blooming perennials
Yarrow (*Achillea* spp.) in white
Sedum (*Sedum* spp)
Hydrangea paniculata
Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle'
- 11  Plant 1-3 Crab Apple (*Malus hupehensis*) in Spring 2025
alongside western boundary
- 12  Grassland
Emorsgate EM3 or similar mix



North boundary hedge to be improved in Autumn 2023
Remove the dead elm
Ash showing signs of dieback. Pollarding to reduce height.
Plant with new native mixed hedge species to thicken hedge and create improved wildlife habitat and nesting

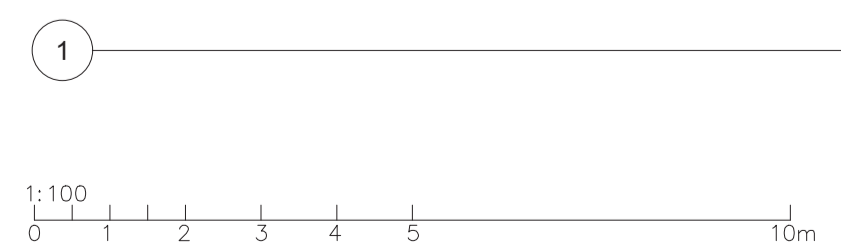
EV Charging point
