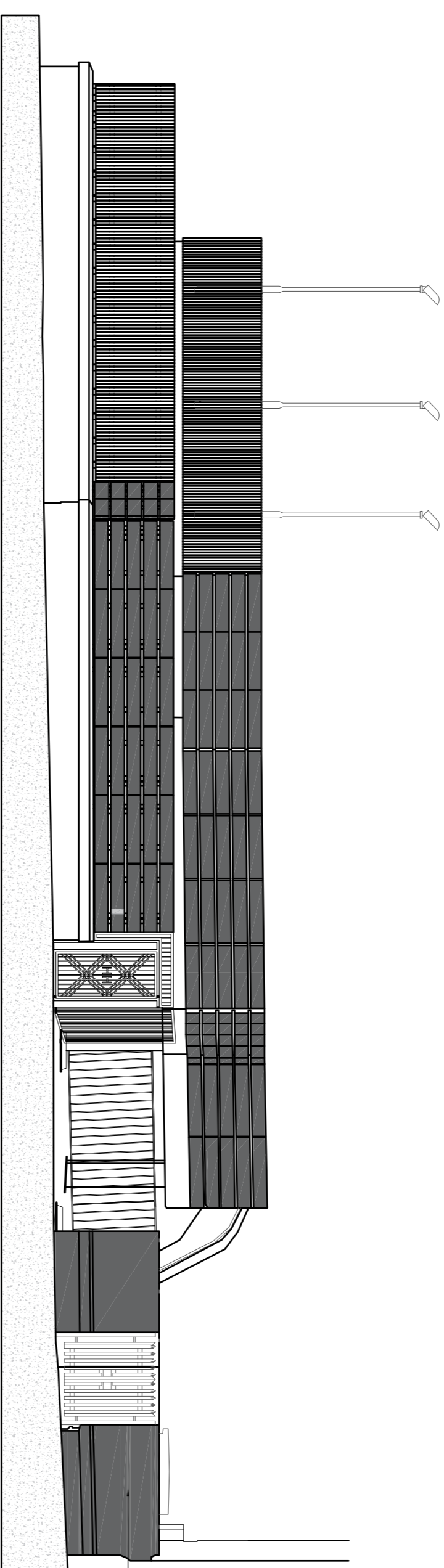
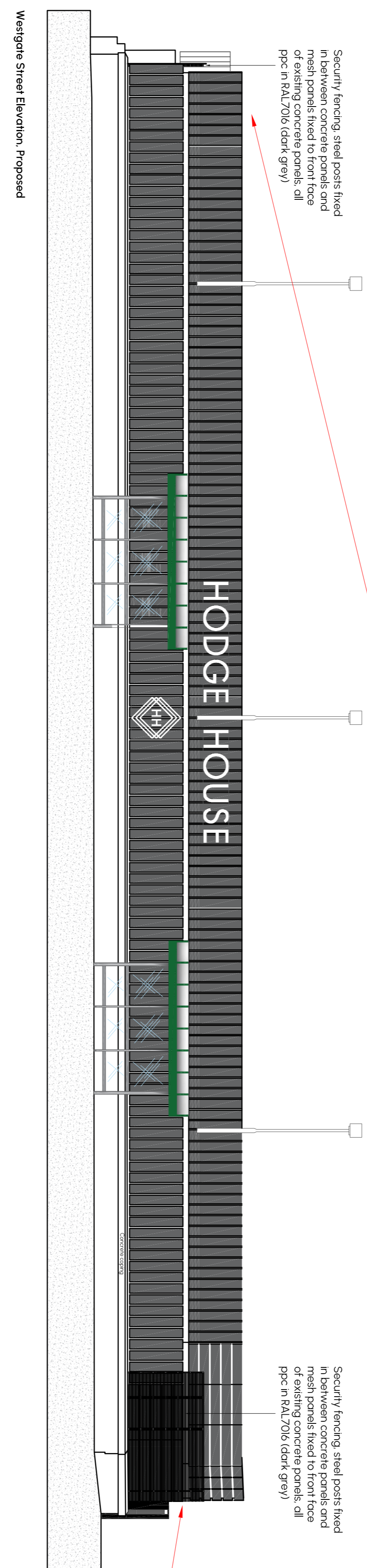


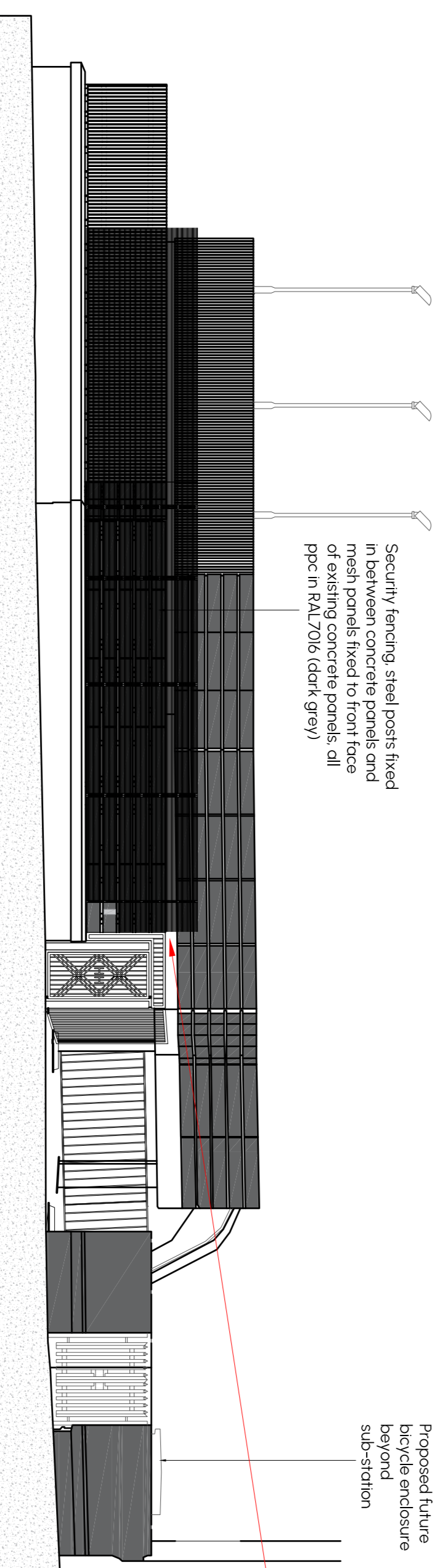
Westgate Street Elevation, Existing (prior to installation of security fencing)



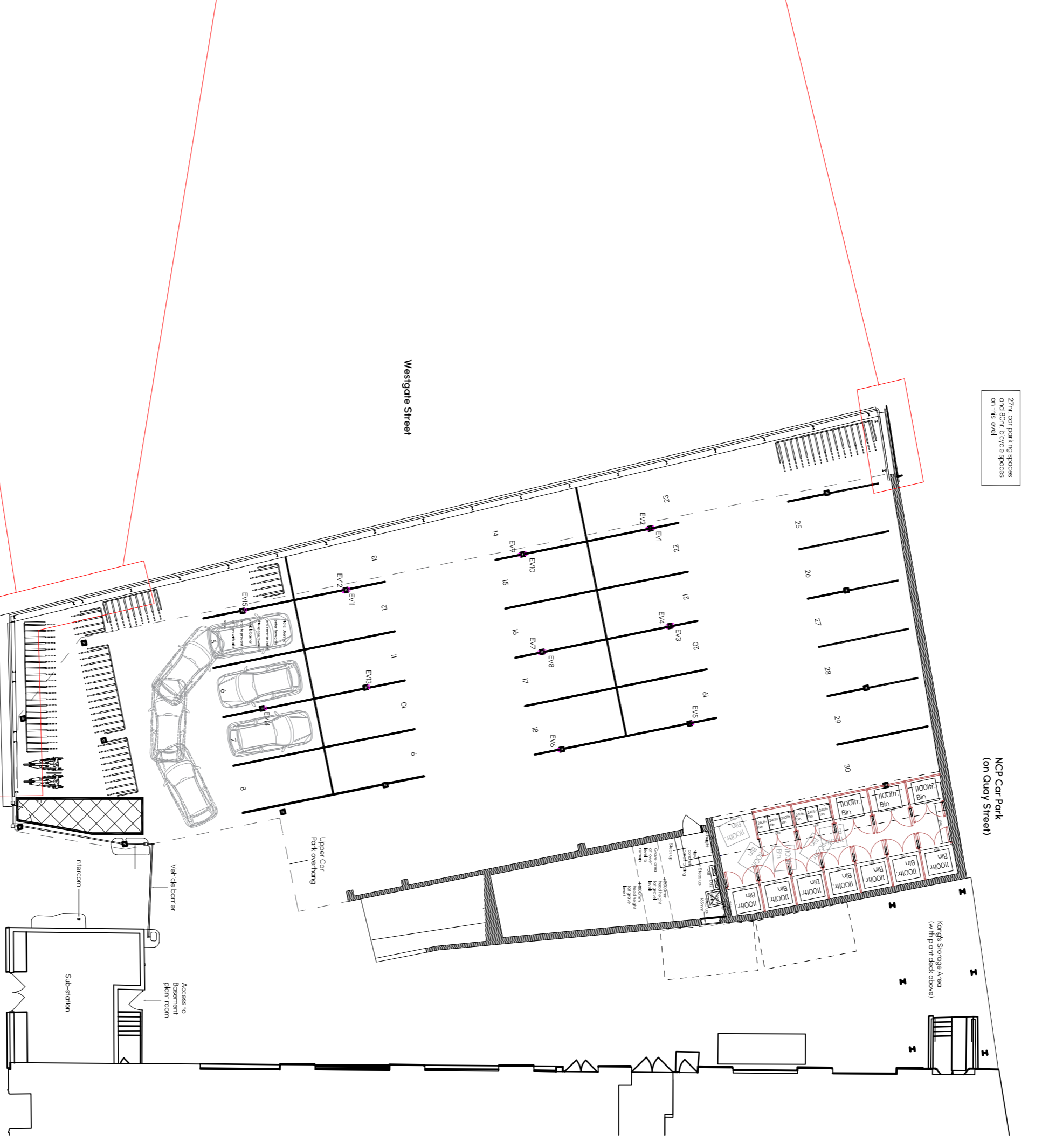
Guildhall Place Elevation, Existing (prior to installation of security fencing)
