Group of Fraxinus Excelsior (Common Ash), interspersed throughout garden woodland, marked at chest height with red/white barrier tape. Trees 1-11 are infected with Chalara caused by the fungus Hynenoscyphus Fraxinius. This infection is now prolific in the North East of England.
