Location description: Two rear garden oak trees tagged 3050 and 3951 in number 10. Both trees are part of a historical rear boundary line of mature oak trees behind the houses. Both trees have normal physiological health. 3051 has been previously reduced. A third tree located to the south west overhangs the south west corner of the garden also.

Tree location: Rear garden of 10 Coed y Bryn, Blackwood.

Tree species: Quercus robur – oak.

Tag: T1. 3050 east tree and T2 3051 west tree. No tag on south west overhang tree T3.

Tree Defects:

T1 3050:

- Historical surface changes around RPA.
- Garden walls/sheds present.
- No obvious tree physiological decline.
- Normal visual and resonance testing.
- Dead wood.
- Rubbing branches.
- Low crown epicormic shoots.

T2 3051:

- Historical RPA changes.
- Walls and structures in rooting area.
- Southern buttress root semi cut/damaged. No obvious decay/decline.
- Ivy on stem and into crown.
- Epicormic shoots on stem.
- Minor dead wood.
- Historical reduction of crown has left two main leaders over conservatory roof.

T3 South west tree:

- Minor dead wood in crown over garden.
- Foliage extension over patio area.

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Action required:

T1 3050:

- 1. Remove dead wood and rubbing branch sections from crown.
- 2. Remove epicormic shoots up to 5m.
- Potential for crown reduction by up to 1.5m at suitable lateral branches using natural target pruning to ensure tree remains around current dimensions. Blend pruning into adjacent East Oak group crowns.

T2 3051:

- 1. Ongoing periodic review.
- 2. Remove all ivy and minor dead wood from tree and crown.
- 3. Reduce North crown extension over conservatory roof only by up to 1.5-2m back to sound live suitable lateral branches.
- 4. Retain remaining crown extents as they are.
- 5. Remove epicormic shoots up to 5m height.

T3 South west tree:

- 1. Reduce crown back towards boundary by a maximum of 2m at suitable lateral branches. Target cut diameter to not exceed 60mm.
- 2. Remove dead wood over number 10 garden.
