#### 1. Introduction

This Landscape Management Plan sets out the management and maintenance responsibilities for all soft landscape areas. The management and maintenance responsibilities are to be carried out in accordance with the details in this document. This Landscape Management plan is to be read in conjunction with the landscape plan.

#### 2. Management Responsibilities & Objectives

The management and maintenance responsibilities will run for a minimum of 5 years, commencing on the date of practical completion. At the end of the 5-year establishment period it is recommended that the management operations in this document are reviewed. This will allow for sustainable long-term management of the landscape.

All soft landscaping should be carried out in the planting season October to March.

- o Maintain soft landscape areas as specified in this document
- Replace any trees or plants that die within a period of 5 years from the date of practical completion
- o Ensure early establishment and healthy growth of all newly planted shrubs, trees and herbaceous planting
- Ensure long term health of all plant stock
- o Ensure horticultural practices are followed
- o Maximise the ecological benefit where appropriate
- Ensure health & safety practices followed
- o Ensure risk assessments are undertaken prior to undertaking maintenance operations
