Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works
Please identify the tree(s) and provide a full and clear specification of the works you want to carry out
The tree concerned is one of seven silver birches with TPOs assigned. It is the large one that is in the rear garden of 65 Hogmoor road. On the plan it relates to G1 the rear of 65 Hogmoor Road, and is the only one, the one on the left of the plan, that is actually in the rear garden of 65.
Proposal is to lop part of two to three branches on the right hand side of the tree as viewed from th house at 65 Hogmoor Road. This is to bring the tree back into the property boarder of 65 Hogmoor Road and to prevent further tree deposits falling in to the chimney void of the house at number 7 Gorsedown Close, who have reported that this is filling the chimney void and causing a fire hazard to a chimney that is currently used.
This procedure has been previously carried out in the summer of 2018 for similar reasons, where permission was granted in that instance.
You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
