Dear Mr Coggles,

Our land borders the river Wensum and we have concerns about an ash tree that splits into 2 trunks at low level. One trunk leans over the river and has been condemned by Bob Bambridge, tree surgeon, as dead - the other trunk is in reasonable order. Our application asks for permission to cut the dead trunk down to approx 3m from ground level - the main reason is to prevent it falling into the river. We also apply to remove a dead silver birch and to generally remove deadwood from our other ash trees (we acknowledge the latter work may not need to be part of the application).

We did a similar operation to an adjacent ash under Imogen Mole in 2020 and have assumed the process is the same so we have included; a Statement for Support of Section 211 Tree Work, a Section 211 Notice, photographs and a plan of the site.
