## <u>SUPPORTING STATEMENT FOR PROPOSED NEW GARAGE AND REAR PORCH</u> EXTENSION AT 79 HOPE STREET, INVERKEITHING, FIFE, KY11 1LN

We have been asked by the new owners of the house, Mr & Mrs Padilla, to remove an old 1970's green painted timber framed porch extension to the rear of the building with the associated white UPVC drainage and rainwater pipes. The existing porch is an eye sore on the rear of the building and Mr & Mrs Padilla feel that a more sympathetically designed porch would improve the look of the rear elevation dramatically.

We are not sure but it looks like the external store roof has been altered at some stage to allow light into a cupboard next to the ground floor bedroom. It is intended to reform the roof to match the existing slated finish and build up the old window and form a new ground floor WC.
