REPAIRS TO THE SOUTHERN SECTION OF THE CHURCHYARD BOUNDARY WALL

DESIGN AND ACCESS STATEMENT

BACKGROUND

The original building dates from 1819 and was designed by the Architect John Russell of Leamington. It is Grade II* Listed Building (National Heritage list entry no.1115663).

The church is an early example of a Catholic Chapel, built at the expense of Lord Dormer. The building is in a pre-archaeological Gothic Revival style.

DESIGN

The damaged section of wall approximately 14 linear metres in length is to be carefully taken down, salvaged bricks cleaned off and reused in the rebuilding with lime based mortar.

ACCESS

Existing means of access to the churchyard will remain.
