

Proposed work

T1 – Ornamental Norway Maple – Reduce 2 – 3 metres.

The tree is growing in a narrow strip of ground between the road and the large garden wall. The proposed work is to reduce the tree by 2 metres to keep the tree in a manageable size. The tree is growing into the roof of the building and rather than proposing the pruning of the back side of the tree I feel it necessary to manage the whole crown. If the tree is left to grow to a fully sized mature specimen, there is a risk due to the lean of the tree than is may wind throw and cause damage to the foundations of the building and the garden wall.



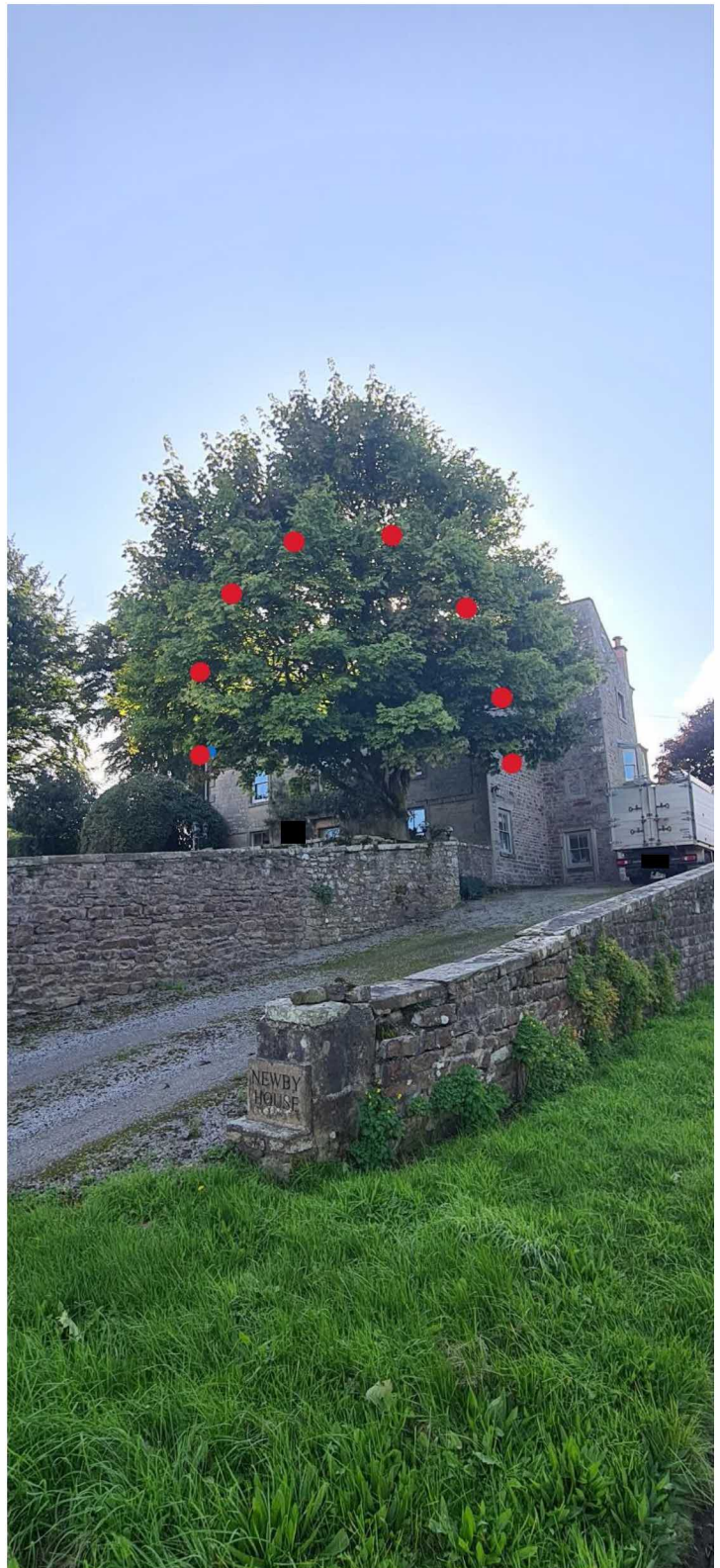

T2 – Norway Maple – Reduce 2 / 3 metres.

The tree has previously been reduced to keep the tree in a manageable size next to the house. It is growing in a confined space and is in turn pushing walls with its base. Keeping the tree in a manageable size is the aim to keep wind heave at manageable levels to prevent excessive damage to the walls.

T3 – Hornbeam – Reduce 50% (5/6 metres)

The tree has become too large, growing next to a building and overhanging the roof significantly. Last year we reduced the other Hornbeam in the garden by the same proportions and I attach a picture (Right) showing the brilliant regeneration of the tree in one season. The aim is basically to replicate this result to keep the trees at a manageable size.
