Farming practices at Broadgate Farm

At Broadgate Farm we rear wagyu calves from 2 weeks old to finishing cattle, other cattle are also sold at 14 months old to Brock auction mart.

The calves are fed twice a day, bedding and feeding is daily with weekly extra husbandry being provided by our vet. Other welfare needs are met daily as required.

We are registered as Red Tractor Assurance- Beef & Lamb Scheme

Water from the biomass boiler this system is also checked twice a day and used for calf feeding, washing down and building heating.

We range from muck spreading, chain harrowing, rolling, mowing, silo harvesting, baling, wrapping and wood chipping,

Tractors and machines are maintained in the farm workshop.

rebuilding of stone wall gaps and fencing as required.

Recently we have re-concreted a yard area, renewing drains and grids to RPA specification.

Over the winter months we graze fields for breeding sheep for 2 local farmers.
