Thank you for taking my call. As requested please see attached photos of the overgrown hedging as discussed. I have taken a few photos so hopefully you can get an idea of scale. The hedging on the RHS of the photo is around 6/7 ft tall, the request relates to the holly and hawthorn “trees” on LHS of the photo. The intention would be to reduce the height to bring these inline with the hedge height, to allow more sunlight to hit the cottage wall.

> We own Bacons Cottage on Crow street in Henham and the roadside external wall is suffering with a bit of damp. One of the causes of that it is constantly in shade due to the hedge becoming excessively overgrown between the cottage and Crow Street and now being more like trees (Holly and hawthorn). I would like to reduce the height of these to get them back to hedging. This would mean reducing it to about half, a reduction to about 8 foot high. Do I need any specific permissions to do this please or can we go ahead and get this done?
