I am asking for permission to crown clean and crown lift up to 5m and to prune back from war memorial, street lighting, public footpath and roadside to give a 1-2 meter clearance whilst maintaing a balanced crow and aesthetical aspects of the trees. The trees lower branches are encroaching on the war memorial and footpaths etc. there are some small areas of deadwood that will beremoved for health and safety reasons. The trees are identified in the attached photographs with relevant tree identification numbers.
