Heating Instructions:

The property is heated by a gas combi boiler and is controlled via a control unit located next to the microwave in the kitchen.

There are radiators in each room that also have their own thermostatic controls at the bottom corner of the radiator.

There is also a wall mounted electric fire in the dining room that has a remote control on the top of the fire.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NONE OF THE OPEN FIREPLACES ARE FUNCTIONAL. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO LIGHT A FIRE IN ANY OF THE FIREPLACES.

Hot Water:

The hot water is heated by the gas combi-boiler located in the storeroom in the kitchen. This will operate when you turn on the tap or shower.

Please note that the shower in the upstairs bathroom is an electric power shower and the isolator switch outside the bathroom must be set to on.

For your safety there is a carbon monoxide alarm located next to the gas boiler.

Washing Machine:


There is a washer/dryer in the store cupboard at the end of the kitchen. The use of this is straight forward but the manual can be found in the appliance instructions folder.




