It is proposed to replace two wooden vent structures on the old cowhouse roof. One has now been blown off during high winds and the other is beyond repair. It is proposed to replace them, like for like using a softwood frame and larch wood cladding/ vents. The larch will weather naturally and resemble the colour of the original structures. The remaining original vent had an asbestos roof. This will be removed and disposed of in accordance with current regulations, It is proposed that the new vents will have a lead roof, with lead flashing. It will be necessary to strip back a small area of roof to fit the vents. The pan tiles will be repositioned once the vents are in place.
