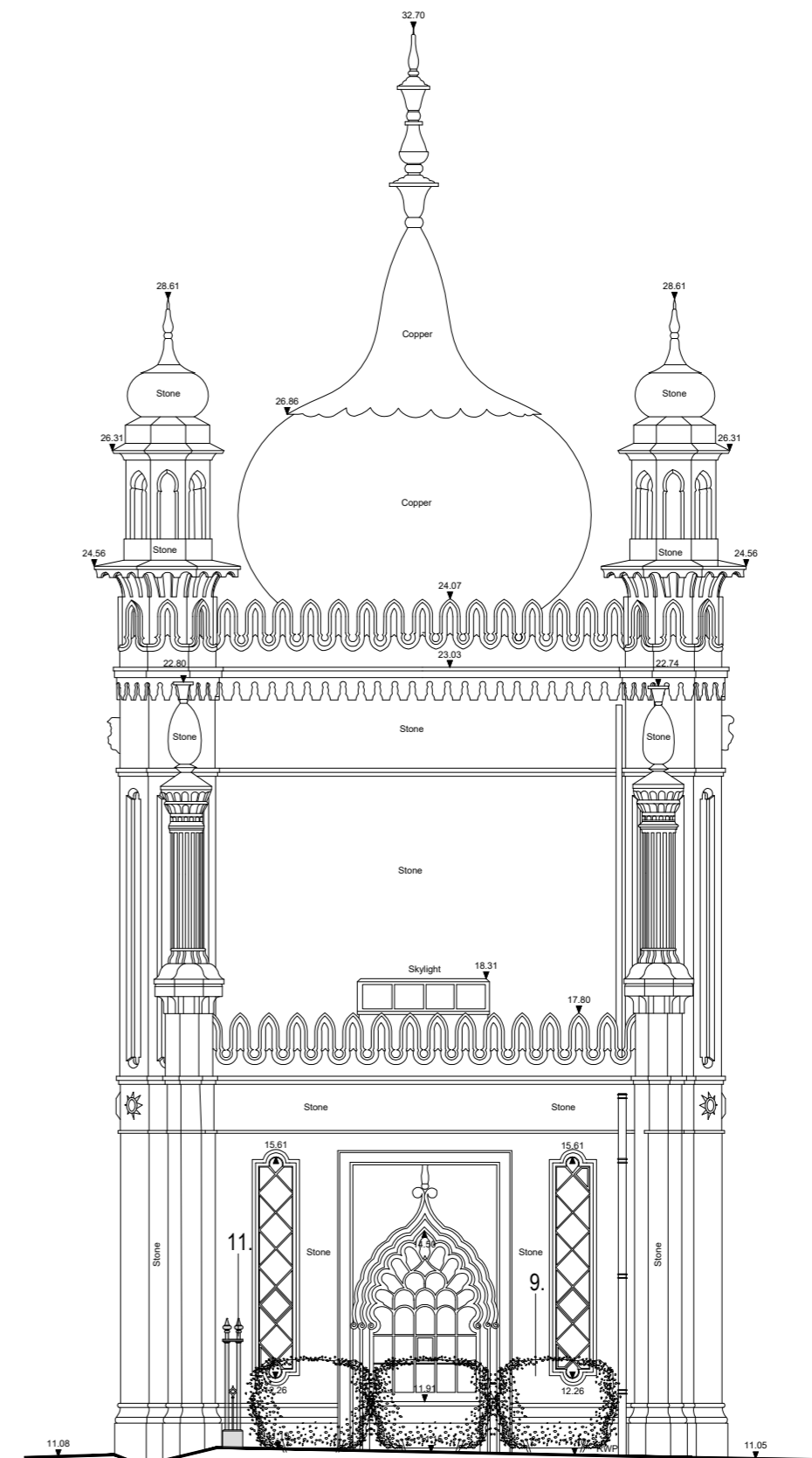
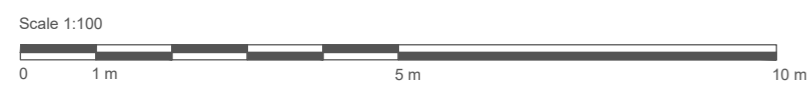


**PROPOSED BOUNDARY - NORTH GATE**
