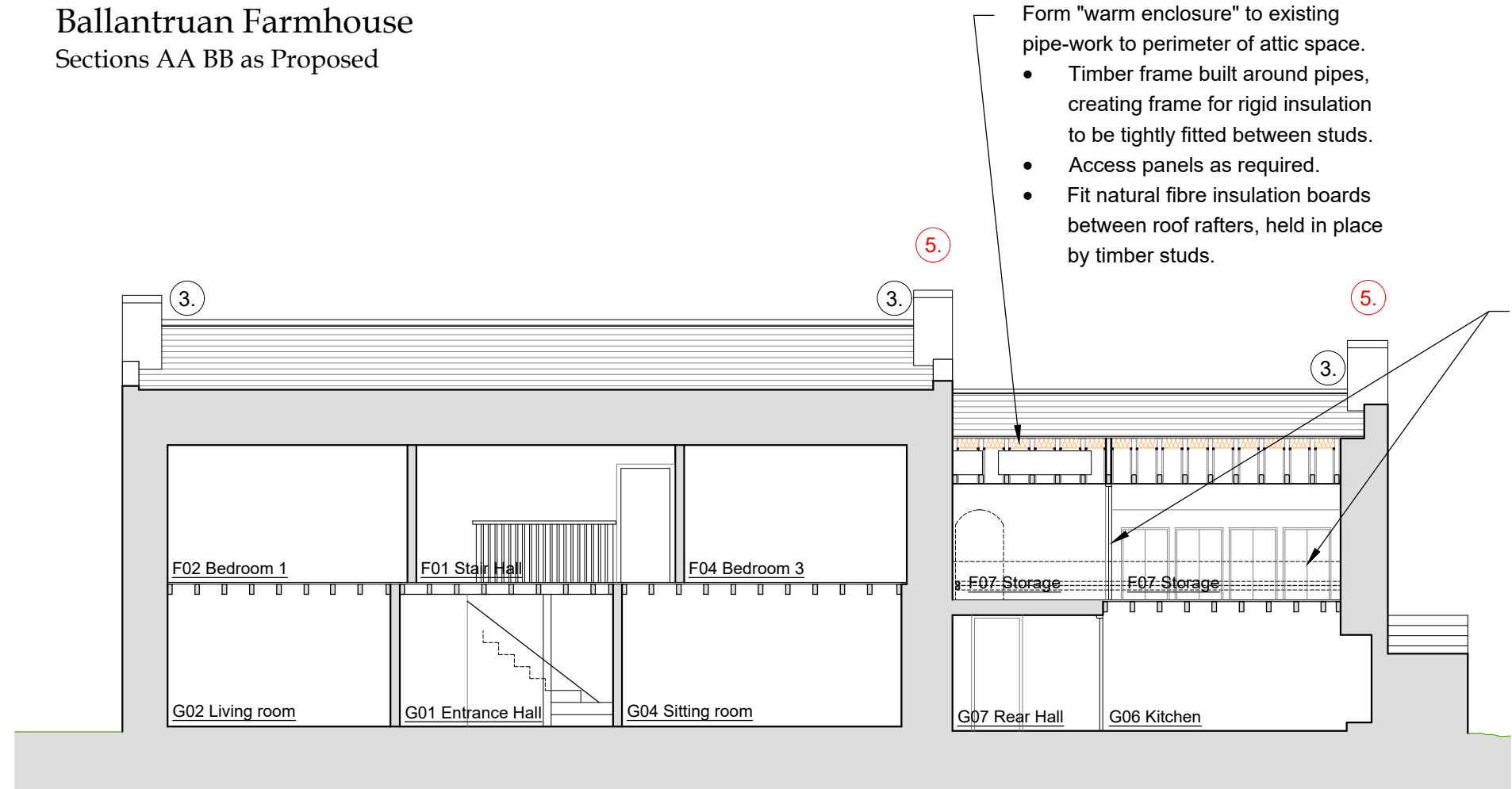


# Ballantruan Farmhouse

## Sections AA BB as Proposed



**NOTE**  
Do not scale from this drawing - all dimensions should be checked on site by the contractor prior to construction and discrepancies notified to the architect immediately.

This drawing should be read in conjunction with the architect's drawings, specification and schedules, and those provided by the other consultants.

For information on known hazards and general health & safety issues prior to work on site, reference should be made to the Pre-Construction Health & Safety Pack.

Form partition to separate new Plant Room and Storage area.

- Centrally positioned double doors to Plant Room.
- New eaves storage with cupboard access to shelving.
- Sheet over existing rafters and ceiling ties to create plasterboard finish to entire area.
- Allow for access to existing water tanks.

### LISTED BUILDING CONSENT NOTES

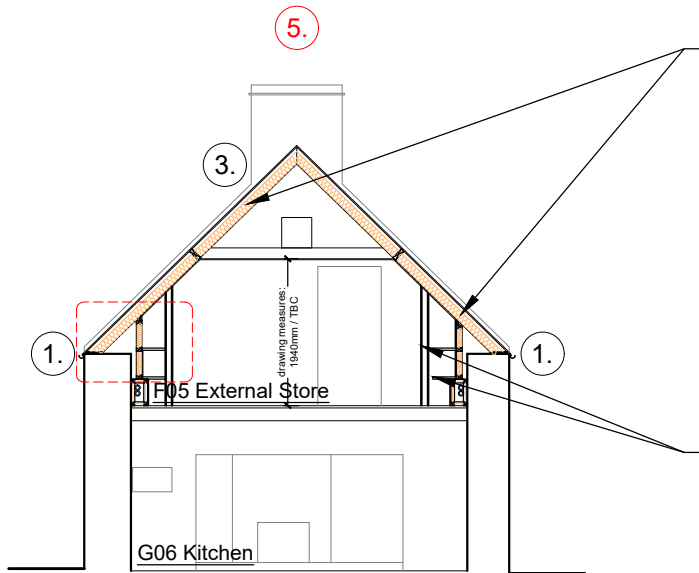
1. Overhaul and renew rhones.
2. Fit new Conservation Rooflights; CR07-2, (W) 463mm x (L) 622mm from The Rooflight Company.
3. Replace cement haunchings, fillets and any concealed flashings with lead watertight details to ensure future water tightness.
4. Renew cement pointing to skewes with lime mortar.
5. All existing chimney pots / caps to be removed.
6. Form new escape window from existing sash and case window to Bedroom 1. Existing window carefully removed.

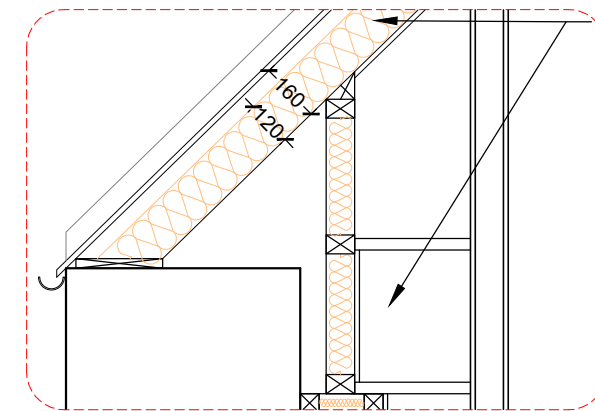

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### Inset Detail 1

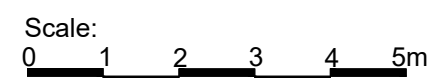
