

## **7. Identification of Tree(s) And Description of Works**

The subject trees are Limes x2 identified as T1 & T2 a Thuja T3 and a Chestnut T4 located in the grounds of Cleremedes a detached property within the Kingsclere Conservation Area.

### **Description of the Work**

Cut back to sound growth points and or other unions branches and limbs raising the crown so as to ensure a clearance height of 5.3m above the carriageway of Foxs Lane.

All work to be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998: 2010 Tree Work - Recommendations, employing target pruning technique. No climbing irons will be used.

### **Reason for the Work**

Hampshire County Council in that Council's capacity as the Highway Authority have requested the applicant undertake this work.

## **8. Additional Information**

The Highway Authority have cited s154 of the Highways Act 1980 as their authority to request the work be carried out so as to ensure free passage along the Adopted Highway of Foxs Lane.

The work, if approved, will also reduce the risk of damage to the trees as a result of their being struck by large goods vehicles thus ensuring and maintaining the continued positive contribution that these trees make to the amenity of the area.
