Facing east from site towards flank of Don Beni restaurant opposite site entrance.



Facing towards site entrance (marked by silver car), with entrance to Winkfield Road to right of image. Note, established (off-site) landscaping which will screen the dwellings from one of the defined important vistas through the Conservation Area as defined in the Appraisal document. Also note kerb-side refuse bin collection point for Winkfield Road properties.
