Hello Nicola

Thank you very much for your reply, and apologies for the delayed response on our part - I've been away on business.

I've tried my best to photograph the area, but it's not easy to do it justice - they are absolutely huge trees. I hope the attached images help.

At the widest point, the trees extend approximately 6 meters beyond the boundary into the property, so in total around 7 metres in total length from the trunk.

Our intention is to shorten these by a maximum of 3.5 metres, to allow for regrowth. This will open up more sunlight to the garden and hopefully stop the failure of the shrubbery along that line.
