There are 3 beech trees planted on the boundary of our home (2 Wensum Valley Close), with the neighbour at 10 Wensum Valley Close. The trees overhang our property considerably.

We wish to trim back the lower branches of 3 beech trees, as they currently overhang our garden considerably. We will cut up to 7m in height maximum.

We are appointing a professional tree surgeon to do the work to ensure that tree will not be damaged or hurt by the work and that its health is fully preserved.

The only limbs to be pruned are minor in size.

The accompanying sketch shows the location of the 3 trees, and their proximity to our boundary, along with an illustration of the proposed pruning / trim.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
