Tree location: T1 on west gate external boundary. T2 inside gate to east of drive.

Tree species: T1 Beech. T2 Cherry.

T1 has a slightly phototropic from to the south and east due to a previous tree being located to the west. T1 is outgrowing the one-sided form and will self-optimise its crown form. Normal resonance test. No overall concerns with tree health. T2 also has a phototropic crown to the north and east. Historical pruning is noted.

Tree Defects:

T1:

- Low foliage tips over drive.
- Squirrel damaged branches.
- Rubbing branches.

T2:

- Rubbing branches.
- Deadwood sections.
- Crown extension to north and east.

Action required:

T1:

- 1. Lift low foliage tips over drive to 3.5-4m using natural target pruning.
- Climb tree and check for excessively damaged branches and prune out/reduce sections as required.
- 3. Re balance crown density.
- 4. Remove any dead wood sections.

T2:

- 1. Remove dead wood and rubbing branches.
- 2. Reduce low east limb tips by up to 3m at suitable lateral branches to maintain natural silhouette.
- 3. Potential minor crown tip reduction required to balance tree silhouette.
