## Hello Oliver.

Thanks for your email. Please find further photographs attached, as requested. I have attached one photograph of each of the trees and one showing you the view from the bottom of the garden to the top, which shows how the lower branches are covering the flower bed, (tree 6 and the view will be sent in a separate email).

There are six trees to be pruned. These have all been pruned previously and as you can see from the photographs are currently covering the flower bed beneath and so the intention is to remove lower branches to provide light for the flowers in the flower bed below.

It may also be possible to lift the crowns of the larger trees, this work has been carried out in the past. This would be by approximately 4-6 feet. Where thinning the crown is required, this could be by approximately 10% of the overall tree. I am unable to draw lines on photographs.



I am very happy to meet with a tree officer and show them the trees and discuss the work we require, by prior arrangement. I know in the past they would visit and speak to my father and give him a lot of support regarding the very same set of trees, which provide the boundary between ourselves and our neighbours at number 44 Davenport Avenue. Sadly, my father died recently and took his knowledge of the trees with him.
