Description Of Proposed Development : 1 - Irish Yew - reduce height to top of wall. G2 - Cotoneaster x4 - reduce height to top of wall. 0170 - Western Red Cedar - Crown lift to 0.5m over the wall. Clear cross by 1.0m. 0171 Conifer group - Crown lift to 0.5m over the wall. 0175 & 0176 - Beech x2 - Crown clean by removing crossed branches up to 40mm in diameter and remove major deadwood throughout whole crown area (Deadwood > 30mm in diameter)

Location: Quenington Cemetery Fowlers Hill Quenington Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 13 November 2023 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.

The development falls under Schedule 2 of the above regulations and is within a "sensitive area" because it falls within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as defined in Regulation 2, subparagraph (1) Interpretation. Having considered the criteria stated within Schedule 3 the Local Planning Authority concludes that it will have no significant environmental effects having regard to its nature, size and location and therefore **will not** require the submission of an Environmental Impact Assessment.
