

**General FLA Notes**

The purpose of this licence is to enable a silvicultural thin to promote development of better formed trees, targeting poor health ash and trees of health and safety concern.

Prior to felling operations, an operation and environmental constraints and hazards site survey will be undertaken. The results of which will be published in a constraints and hazards plan to inform the process of operations.

A site survey will also be undertaken to assess the presence of any European Protected Species and other ecological constraints such as nesting birds or badgers. An FC EPS checklist will be completed and the results of all searches and surveys will inform the process of operations.

The felling area is part of an area TPO 06/00078/TPO but does not fall within a conservation area. Research using the MAGIC Maps online platform has revealed that the felling areas do not fall within any designations, statutory or otherwise apart from the Cotswolds AONB.
