Hi Mark

Thank you for sending the application for proposed tree work at Clearwell Cemetery. I have forwarded the application to the planning admin team for registration. Once registered the application will be assigned a planning application number. However before it can be validated there are a couple of aspects that require clarification.

With regards to T7, I assume this is the Sycamore tree that you are referring to. On the application form you state that you intend to cut back the branches, but do not say by how much. I would be most grateful if you could let me know if this will be a crown lift, and if so by how many metres above ground. Otherwise, if it is just to reduce the length of the branches please state by how much the branches are to be cut back by (again the extent of reduction should be expressed in terms of by how many metres).

With regards to B1 (Laurel bushes), you state that the intention is to either cut them back or possibly remove completely. For the purposes of the application, it cannot be dealt with as an either/or proposal. Therefore the proposal should be only one of the options. If the intention is to cut them back it should be expressed in terms of by how many metres. Otherwise, please state that the intention is complete removal.

I hope you are able to provide the information I have requested, and look forward to hearing back from you.

I have copied in our Clearwell PCC representative, the other churchwarden for the parish and our church administrator.

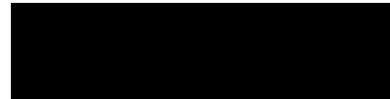
This work is part of the development of an overall management plan for the cemetery which will include work beyond the borders of the conservation area.
