### Trees adjacent to Church Lane, Carnaby

The council's forestry service has highlighted that there are multiple dead trees, mainly elms, on your land on Church Lane, Carnaby which require urgent felling to prevent any potential risk to users of the highway. I have attached a document with a location plan showing the area in question coloured yellow along with photographs of some of the trees.

I would be grateful if you could notify me of the intended timescale to carry out work to make the trees safe. Due to the serious nature of this matter I would appreciate your response within **28 days** from the date of this letter. As you may be aware the trees are covered by a tree preservation order and you **must** give a minimum of 5 days advance notification of the intention to carry out this work to [planning.trees@eastriding.gov.uk](mailto:planning.trees@eastriding.gov.uk).
