

## Internal alterations

While our property is of historical interest and importance (built on the land of a former Roman settlement with the core of Weycroft Manor built in the 15th century, however a fire just two years ago 2020 gutted the roof and first floor and was renovated under the strict guidance of English heritage to suit the needs of the previous owner. We will only change the interior fixtures of the bathroom and not effect joinery ,doors archives skirtings etc. although carpet will be removed for a waterproof-slip free surface.
