I am writing to you to object to the proposal plan to erect a first floor balcony to the rear of 94a High Street, Newton le Willows.

[REDACTED] The balcony if allowed to proceed will overlook directly into my garden leaving us with absolutely no privacy.

As you will find our garden is presently overlooked by residents of Willow Court. To have some privacy I created a patio area against the wall between Willow Court and my garden. This area we enjoy to sit outside and have a small degree of privacy from our neighbours.

However if the proposed balcony is allowed then we will have absolutely no privacy whatsoever. It is heartbreaking to think that we will not be allowed to have a space to enjoy our small garden and have some privacy from neighbours. My wife would be unable to sunbathe in fear of being looked at. The proposed balcony at a further 1.8 metres in height will also take a large amount of sunlight from our garden. It would tower over our garden and would have a very negative impact on our family and I simply ask that you take the time to come to my home and see what impact the proposed changes would have.

I ask that you please consider all of the above and not grant this proposal.
