The Ash tree at the above property has been historically crown raised, this has left some cavities on the main stem, leading up to the first main lateral limbs It has also had a significant amount of height removed historically, this has lead to decay in the upper sections of the main stem, and lots of weakly attached reactive growth.

The tree is unbalanced, with much of the canopy to one side.

Whilst some of the lower canopy is fairly dense, nearly all the upper canopy is quite sparse, with two large areas dying back, leaving significant deadwood throughout Some of this deadwood is now starting to fail, and fall on the driveway and footpath / road below

Considering the overall poor condition of the tree, significant dieback in the upper canopy, and already very poor aesthetic form of the tree, the client would like to remove the tree.

It no longer has a positive contribution to the area, and any remedial safety works will be at further detriment to the aesthetics of the tree, without solving the long term issues for its longevity, considering its overall condition
