



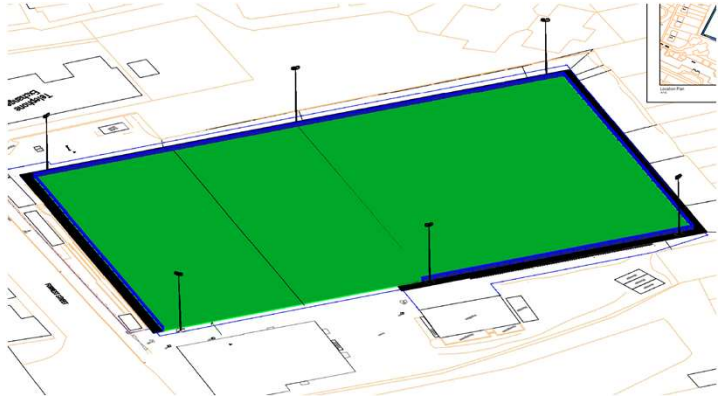
Operational Statement - Pitch Floodlighting



Existing Floodlighting

Currently there is existing Floodlighting around the Football Pitch which hasn't been maintained and no longer in operation.

Within the new pitch development, we look upgrade the Existing Floodlighting and Introduce Light Emitting Diode (LED) Floodlighting which offers further energy maintenance savings as well as producing less light pollution to nearby residents etc. The further benefits from LED lighting is we can control lighting to specific areas of the pitch utilising areas only that are in use.

Proposed times of Floodlighting use within Winter Season are:

Mon to Friday: 17.00pm to 22.00pm

Sat & Sun: 17.00pm to 20.00pm



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Existing Developments with BVFC Proposed Floodlighting

In the surrounding area of Blantyre and Hamilton similar 3G football Pitches have been previously installed which are in operation with the same proposed LED Floodlighting Hours working to 22.00PM Mon to Fri and 20.00PM at weekends.

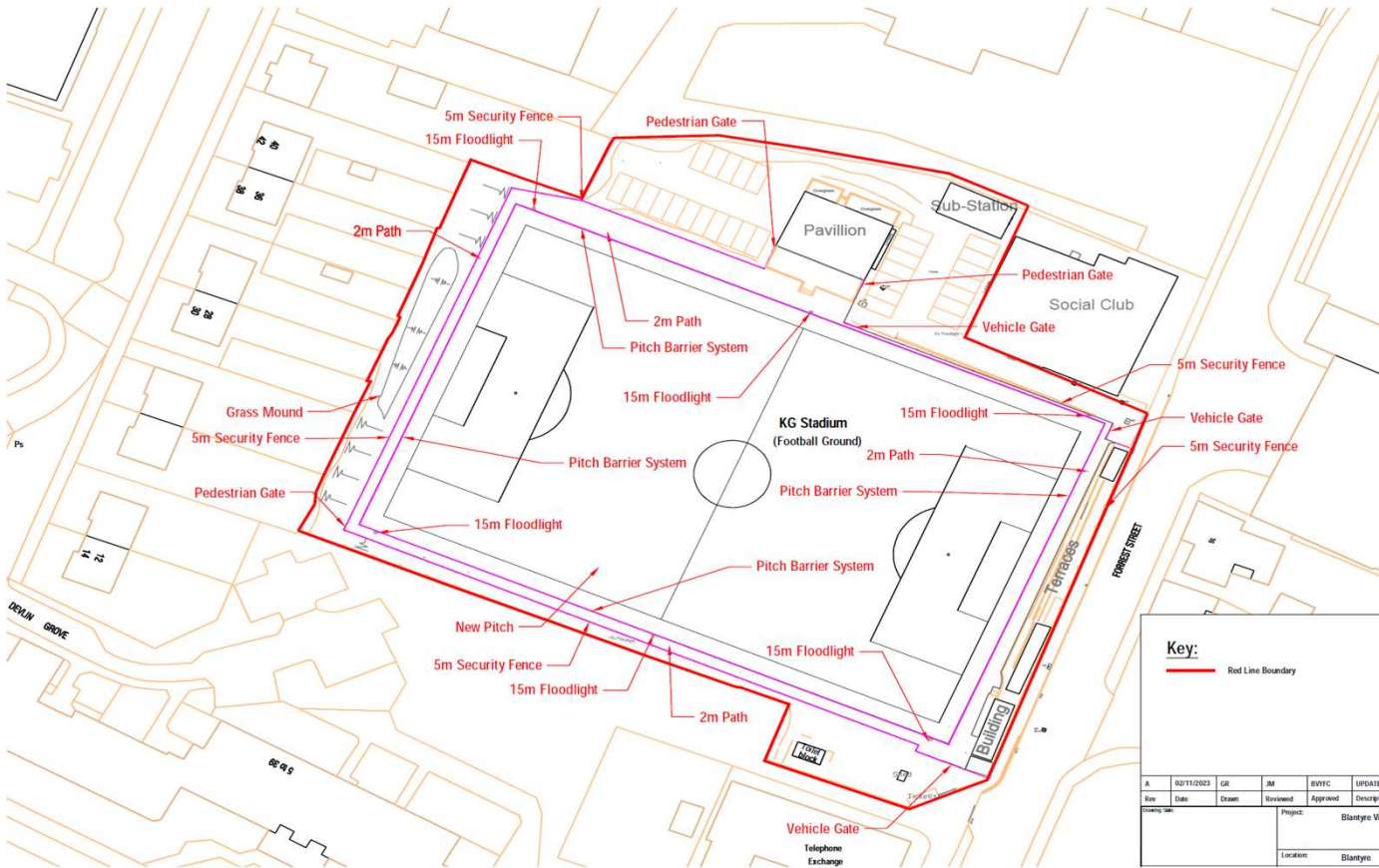
Our Blantyre Victoria Youth Teams all currently use the facilities.

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Key Areas of Design

During the feasibility stage of the new Pitch Consultations BVFC have taken cognisance of Local residents and proposed position of Pitch to least impact Neighbours from Light and Noise Pollutions as demonstrated below by forming a mound to West of the site acting as Acoustic and Privacy barrier.
