This decision has been made after assurances made from the contractor and Local authority that all appropriate safeguarding measures and checks are adopted by the contractors and that all appropriate risk assessments are in place. We understand that risk assessments have been undertaken to ensure that the roof can hold the weight of the heat pumps.
