Thank you for consulting us on planning application 2023/3518. Having screened the application, the site in question lies outside the Internal Drainage District of the Norfolk Rivers Internal Drainage Board. As per our Planning and Byelaw Strategy (https://www.wlma.org.uk/uploads/WMA_Planning_and_Byelaw_Policy.pdf) the proposed application is classed as a minor development and does not meet our threshold for commenting. Therefore the Board has no comments to make.
