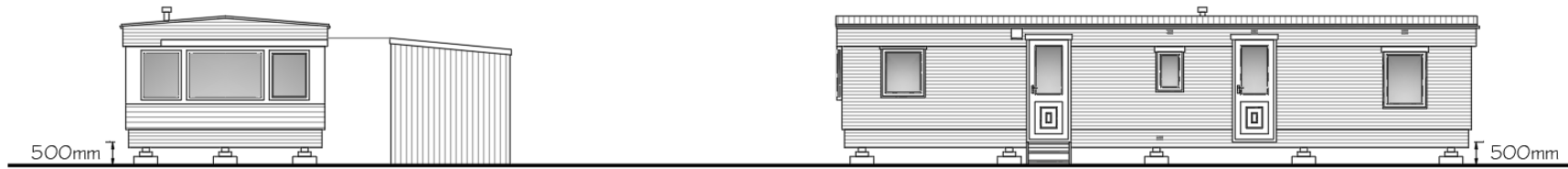

Due to the nature of the site, the caravans floor level is raised 500mm up off the ground. This is to ensure that in the case of any heavy flooding, the habitable space should remain untouched. There are 3 steps up to the finished floor level of the caravan.
