## Other comments:

The site lies close to the historic core of East Tytherley, within an area of archaeological potential related to the origins and development of the settlement. However, the proposed extension is to be largely located within the footprint of the current conservatory. The area of the current conservatory is unlikely to retain any archaeological potential owing to the existing impacts. It is possible that these impacts extend beyond the conservatory footprint but their full extent is unknown. Whilst it is not possible to completely rule out the presence of archaeological remains, given the known existing impacts, on balance, I do not believe that the imposition of an archaeological condition is justified under the terms of NPPF. On this basis, I do not wish to raise any archaeological issues.
