

HERITAGE STATEMENT

8 PARKERSON STREET ROMSEY LIES WITHIN THE HISTORIC CORE OF ROMSEY AND IS AN AREA IDENTIFIED AS HAVING LIMITED ARCHAEOLOGICAL POTENTIAL. THE PROPERTY IS EARLY C19 IS ONE OF A MIDDLE TERRACE CLOSE TO ROMSEY TOWN CENTRE AND IS GRADE II LISTED. IT FALLS WITHIN THE CONSERVATION AREA.

THE TERRACE IS MAINLY RED BRICK WITH TWO OR THREE STOREYS. SOME HAVE BASEMENTS AND ATTIC ROOMS.

THE PROPOSED WORKS WILL NOT BE VISIBLE FROM THE FRONT OF THE HOUSE.

THE CURRENT RAIL BOILER SITED IN THE CHIMNEY AREA OF THE DINING ROOM WILL BE DECOMMISSIONED AND REMOVED.

A RADIANT HEAT CORBI BOILER WILL BE SITED IN THE EXISTING AIRING cupboard

SITED IN BATHROOM. THE EXISTING HOT WATER CYLINDER WILL BE REMOVED.

A VERTICAL FLUE WILL BE SITED EXITING THROUGH THE ROOF SPACE IN EAVES OF GROUND 2. THE WATER TANK IN EAVES WILL BE DISCONNECTED.

THE FLUE WILL BE BLACK THE SMALLEST TYPE LOCAL PHOTO SUPPLIED.
