Use:

To build a comfortable small, seated area attached to the kitchen.

Also, to re-roof the house and upgrade the front doors.

Amount:

There will be one extra room, it will be a comfortable small space to fit a table

and chairs.

The work to the roof and doors will not change the size or appearance of the

house.

Layout:

The extension will take up a small part of the rear patio.

Scale:

The size will be in keeping with the existing features of the house and land.

Landscaping: The property has a large, pleasant garden, the extension will not affect the

Appearance:

The view from the front of the house will hardly change; the extension can
