The building is sited some distance form the primary listed building. It cannot be fully confirmed the actual date of construction. The stables outbuilding has already had planning permission approved for partial repurposing as a gym. Images of the remaining area now repurposed as a golf simulator are all internal. There is no impact on the visual appearance of the stable block. Therefore the works completed to repurpose this section of the stable block to a golf simulator, have a neutral impact on the special architectural and historic interest of the listed building and its setting.

Recommendation: No objection subject to the comments above. Whilst the applicant describes this application as a seeking 'retrospective approval' it should be noted that listed building consent should be applied for prior to any works commencing, not retrospectively.

It is however also noted that the exceptional and somewhat unprecedented circumstances created by the Covid pandemic has resulted in some alternative and perhaps unusual approaches to the completion of certain works in regards to timelines and adhering to the regular planning process.
