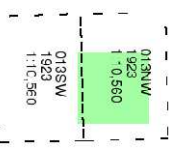
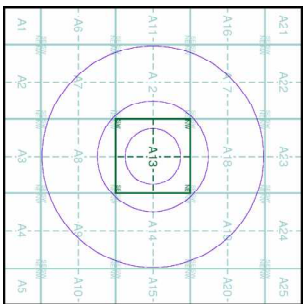


The historical maps shown were reproduced from maps predominantly held at the scale adopted for England, Wales and Scotland in the 1840's. In 1854 the 1:2500 scale was adopted for mapping urban areas; these maps were used to update the 1:10,560 maps. The published date given therefore is often some years later than the surveyed date. Before 1930, all Ordnance Survey maps were produced by hand-drawn methods. The first large-scale aerial photography was taken in 1909, and the first aerial photograph of Essex, showing the site, was produced in 1911. In the late 1940's, a Provisional Edition was produced which updated the 1:10,560 mapping from a number of sources. The maps appear unprinted - with all military camps and other strategic sites removed. These maps were initially overlaid with the National Grid. In 1970, the first 1:10,000 maps were produced using the Transverse Mercator Projection. The revision process continued until recently, with new editions appearing every 10 years or so for urban areas.

Before 1930, all Ordnance Survey maps were produced by the Survey of England, which was a county by county process, producing maps to significant map scales in cutting areas. In the late 1940's, a Provincial Edition was produced which updated the 1:10,560 mapping from a number of sources. The maps appear unmodified - with all military camps and other strategic sites removed. These maps were initially overprinted with the National Grid. In 1970, the first 1:10,000 maps were produced using the Transverse Mercator Projection. The revision process continued until recently, with new editions appearing every 10 years or so for urban areas.

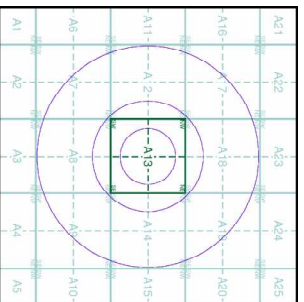

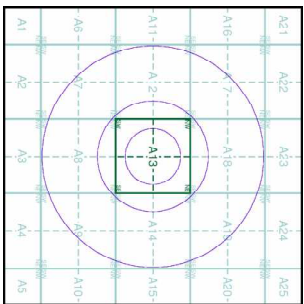

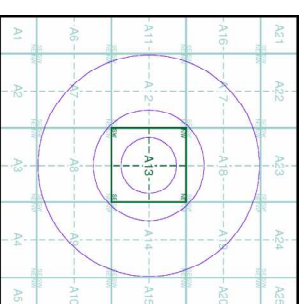

This vector data includes information on the map's projection, datum, county, unitary authority, district, civil parish and constituency.

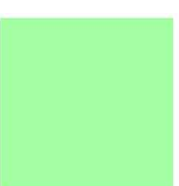

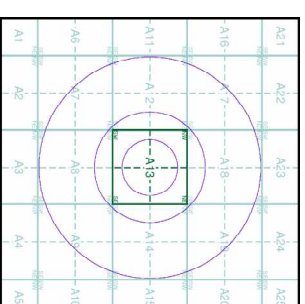
