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The content of this report is based on information available as of November 2023, the validity of the statements made may therefore vary over time as planning guidance and policies as well as the evidence base change.



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1 Introduction

1.1 This Transport Technical Note has been prepared by EAS Transport Planning Ltd on behalf of County & City Developments Ltd (hereinafter referred to as the 'client') regarding the proposed redevelopment of Little Ravenscourt.

The Site

- 1.2 The site under consideration is located within the local neighbourhood of Great Amwell. The full address of the site is Little Ravenscourt, Amwell Hill, Great Amwell, Hertfordshire, SG12 9RA (hereinafter, the 'site').
- 1.3 East Hertfordshire District Council ('EHDC') is therefore the local planning authority, and Hertfordshire County Council ('HCC') acts as the local highway authority.
- 1.4 A map showing the location of the site is contained in **Appendix A**.

The Scheme

- 1.5 It is proposed to develop a new dwelling, set within the northern part of the garden of the existing dwelling known as Ravenscourt.
- 1.6 A new access into the development is proposed off Amwell Hill, which is classified as the A1170.
- 1.7 The proposed site plans are contained at **Appendix B**.

Aims and Structure of this Report

- 1.8 This technical note has been prepared with regard to the Department of Communities and Local Government ('DCLG') Guidance on Travel Plans, Transport Assessments, and Statements in Decision Taking (March 2014); as well as to guidance that the regional and local authorities have published on their website.
- 1.9 The contents of this report are:
 - Section 2 sets the national, regional, and local policy context;
 - Section 3 describes the existing site conditions;
 - Section 4 describes the proposed development;
 - Section 5 identifies the likely impacts by the development; and
 - Section 6 concludes the statement.

2 Policy Context

- 2.1 This section sets out the policy context. Development and growth are encouraged at National, regional, and local level. How this is made sustainable in the longer term is by encouraging walking, cycling and public transport use.
- 2.2 The policy documents reviewed include:
 - National Planning Policy Framework;
 - Hertfordshire's Local Transport Plan;
 - East Herts District Plan; and
 - EHDC Vehicle Parking Provision at New Development.

National Planning Policy Framework

- 2.3 The revised National Planning Policy Framework ('NPPF') was most-recently revised in September 2023 and sets out the government's planning policies for England and how these are expected to be applied.
- 2.4 Planning law requires that applications for planning permission be determined in accordance with the development plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise. The National Planning Policy Framework must be taken into account in preparing the development plan and it is a material consideration in planning decisions. Planning policies and decisions must also reflect relevant international obligations and statutory requirements.
- 2.5 The purpose of the planning system is to contribute to the achievement of sustainable development. At a very high level, the objective of sustainable development can be summarised as meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.
- 2.6 In respect of that, Paragraph 10 of the NPPF states:
 - "So that sustainable development is pursued in a positive way, at the heart of the Framework is a presumption in favour of sustainable development (original emphasis)."
- 2.7 Section 9 of the NPPF is focused on Promoting Sustainable Transport, and states in paragraphs 104 and 105:
 - "104. Transport issues should be considered from the earliest stages of plan-making and development proposals, so that:
 - a) the potential impacts of development on transport networks can be addressed;
 - b) opportunities from existing or proposed transport infrastructure, and changing transport technology and usage, are realised for example in relation to the scale, location or density of development that can be accommodated;
 - c) opportunities to promote walking, cycling and public transport use are identified and pursued;



- d) the environmental impacts of traffic and transport infrastructure can be identified, assessed and taken into account including appropriate opportunities for avoiding and mitigating any adverse effects, and for net environmental gains; and
- e) patterns of movement, streets, parking and other transport considerations are integral to the design of schemes, and contribute to making high quality places.
- 105. The planning system should actively manage patterns of growth in support of these objectives. Significant development should be focused on locations which are or can be made sustainable, through limiting the need to travel and offering a genuine choice of transport modes. This can help to reduce congestion and emissions, and improve air quality and public health. However, opportunities to maximise sustainable transport solutions will vary between urban and rural areas, and this should be taken into account in both plan-making and decision-making."
- 2.8 Paragraphs 110 and 111 state that in assessing applications for development it should be ensured that:
 - "110. In assessing sites that may be allocated for development in plans, or specific applications for development, it should be ensured that:
 - a) appropriate opportunities to promote sustainable transport modes can be or have been taken up, given the type of development and its location;
 - b) safe and suitable access to the site can be achieved for all users;
 - c) the design of streets, parking areas, other transport elements and the content of associated standards reflects current national guidance, including the National Design Guide and the National Model Design Code; and
 - d) any significant impacts from the development on the transport network (in terms of capacity and congestion), or on highway safety, can be cost effectively mitigated to an acceptable degree.
 - 111. Development should only be prevented or refused on highways grounds if there would be an unacceptable impact on highway safety, or the residual cumulative impacts on the road network would be severe."
- 2.9 Furthermore, paragraphs 112 and 113 continue:
 - "112. Within this context, applications for development should:
 - a) give priority first to pedestrian and cycle movements, both within the scheme and with neighbouring areas; and second so far as possible to facilitating access to high quality public transport, with layouts that maximise the catchment area for bus or other public transport services, and appropriate facilities that encourage public transport use:
 - b) address the needs of people with disabilities and reduced mobility in relation to all modes of transport;
 - c) create places that are safe, secure and attractive which minimise the scope for conflicts between pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles, avoid unnecessary street clutter, and respond to local character and design standards;
 - d) allow for the efficient delivery of goods, and access by service and emergency vehicles; and
 - e) be designed to enable charging of plug-in and other ultra-low emission vehicles in safe, accessible and convenient locations.



113. All developments that will generate significant amounts of movement should be required to provide a Travel Plan, and the application should be supported by a Transport Statement or Transport Assessment so that the likely impacts of the proposal can be assessed."

Hertfordshire's Local Transport Plan

- 2.10 The Hertfordshire Local Transport Plan (LTP4, adopted in May 2018) is guided by four key principles:
 - Integration of land use and transport planning;
 - Application and development of technology;
 - Cost-effective delivery and maintenance; and
 - Modal shift and encouraging active travel.
- 2.11 The proposed development will provide an integrated setting in which residents will have access to a range of facilities without needing to leave the site or put any demands on roads or public transport. Providing accommodation for many of the staff and visitors on site will be consistent with this. Active movement, primarily on foot, will benefit health and offer stimulation and will be a key feature of the development.
- 2.12 HCC policy therefore does consider HCC's Climate Emergency declaration, issued in July 2019, which emphasizes the LTP's to assess and advance the potential for sustainable development, through active travel and public transport modes as a priority for development sites, in particular for residential sites located within urban centres.
- 2.13 The LTP4's main policies, by order of importance, are:
 - a. Achieving travel demand reduction and modal shift: A Transport User Hierarchy
 - b. Influencing Travel Behaviour
 - c. Managing New Development
 - d. Accessibility
 - e. Active Travel Walking and Cycling
 - f. Buses
 - g. Rail
 - h. Airports
 - i. Managing the movement of vehicle traffic and freight on the Highway Network
 - j. Road Safety and Security
 - k. Emissions Reduction
 - I. Environment
 - m. Asset Management
- 2.14 From the above it is pertinent to note that HCC prioritise the use and development of sustainable travel modes in achieving a more balanced approach towards demand for travel, moving away from the private car, to support walking, cycling and public transport modes.



2.15 In this regard, the position of LTP4 is that new developments are expected to help sustain existing sustainable travel networks through improved custom and to help develop new networks and infrastructure that promote modal shift to green travel networks.

East Herts District Plan

- 2.16 The District Plan sets out the Council's planning framework for the district. It identifies how East Herts will grow and develop to become an even more desirable and prosperous place to live, work and visit. It covers the period between 2011 and 2033 and consists of a Written Statement and a Policies Map.
- 2.17 The District Plan is based on a number of guiding principles. The principles are based on national policy and legal requirements applied to the local circumstances of the East Herts area. The overarching objective for transport in the borough is to:
 - "1. To allocate sufficient sites in order to meet the full housing needs of East Herts;
 - 2. To prioritise the development of brownfield land and other appropriate sites within the urban areas of the settlements, but to avoid over-development of such sites;
 - 3. To promote self-containment by directing development to areas where there is reasonable proximity to services and facilities, and which reflect existing travel to work areas, school catchments, and retail spend patterns and functional geographies;
 - 4. Wherever possible to utilise readily available features to provide clear and unambiguous Green Belt boundaries;
 - 5. To co-operate with adjoining authorities on cross-boundary strategic matters where it is reasonable to do so;
 - 6. To focus development in locations where the impacts on the historic and natural environment are minimised as far as possible;
 - 7. To acknowledge that the capacity for the market towns and villages to grow is constrained by the existing capacity and future potential of these settlements, and therefore the provision of large-scale strategic development will be required, both within this Plan period and beyond;
 - 8. To protect and enhance the rural area and the Green Belt outside the allocated development areas to maintain the countryside and the rural character of the District;
 - 9. To encourage appropriate development in and around the identified villages, with an opportunity for neighbourhood planning to influence the type and location of development sites."

Vehicle Parking Provision at New Development

- 2.18 The EHDC guidance document Vehicle Parking Provision at New Development was published in 2007, and remains the current Parking Standards document locally.
- 2.19 The purpose of this document is to explain East Herts District Council's approach to vehicle parking provision at new developments. Its intention is to provide clear guidance and more certainty for developers.

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2.20 With regards to car parking, policy TR7 (Car Parking – Standards) of the documents states:

"Car parking provision for new development proposals will be assessed in accordance with the District Council's car parking standards (which should be taken as maximum standards), including coach, cycle, and powered two-wheeler provision. The actual provision made will be determined on a site-specific basis having regard to the proposed use, location, and availability of, or potential for access to, modes of transport other than the private car in accordance with the Council's SPD 'Vehicle Parking Provision at New Development'"

2.21 With regards to cycle parking, policy TR14 of the document, regarding Cycling – Facilities Provision (Residential), states:

"Applications for new residential developments should, where appropriate, demonstrate provision of sufficient cycle storage facilities for occupants of new dwellings to enable cycle usage to become a realistic option to the use of private motorised transport. Such facilities should include appropriate secure, covered, waterproof storage facilities and be provided either within the curtilage of the dwelling or, for example, in the case of flats, within a communal area, provided that such facilities are easily observed and accessible."

2.22 The parking standards use a zonal approach to the local parking requirements, with lower car parking provision permitted within urban areas.

3 Existing Site Assessment

3.1 The site and its surrounding areas are reviewed in terms of transport sustainability, and the adequacy of the local highway network, in context of the proposed scheme.

Site Location and Local Facilities

- 3.2 Appendix A contains a map showing the site's location within Great Amwell.
- 3.3 The site is set to the east of Amwell Hill (A1170), between Church Path and Walnut Tree Walk, and c. 215m to the north of Van Hage Garden Centre and connected commercial complex.
- 3.4 The Van Hage's acts as the local village centre, as well as being a garden centre. Apart from the traditional garden centre area, focusing on gardening stuff, the complex also contains:
 - A Garden Furniture and BBQ department;
 - Seasonal themed shopping outlet (such as Christmas, Spring, and Summer supplies);
 - a large café serving many meals and Sunday roasts, and coffees cakes, etc (with circa 150 covers);
 - a Food Hall, including an in-house green grocer's store and butchers;
 - a clothing department;
 - a Homeware section:
 - a pet and bird care department and a pets play area corner;
 - a range of other businesses including a solar panel centre; and
 - the East Herts Miniature rail line.
- 3.5 There are also two nearby pubs which also have restaurants and are within a short walk. These are the Choppy's Restaurant (Coach and Horses) and the George Fourth PH.
- 3.6 Ware Town Centre is located to the north of the site and is around 1.8km, or a 7-minute cycle, away. It has a wide range of shops and businesses that includes all the day-to-day facilities that may need to be accessed by local residents including:
 - Local Supermarkets;
 - Convenience Stores:
 - Banks;
 - Pharmacies;
 - Doctors;
 - Dentists; and
 - A wide range of shops and businesses.
- 3.7 There are also a number of schools and nurseries within walking distance of the proposed development together with a number of places of worship.



Public Transport - Bus

- 3.8 There are existing bus stops located close to the site, outside the Van Hage Garden Centre on Amwell Hill. From these a total of 3 bus services can be boarded, these being the 310, 351, and the 724 GreenLine services.
- 3.9 Route 310 runs from Hertford to Waltham Cross, via Theobalds Grove, Cheshunt, Turnford, Wormley, Broxbourne, Hoddesdon, St Margarets, Great Amwell, and Ware. There are 4 buses an hour on weekdays, 3 buses an hour on Saturdays and one bus per hour on Sundays.
- 3.10 Route 351 runs from Brent Hertford to Bishop's Stortford, via Ware, St Margarets, Hunsdon, and Hadham. There is 1 bus an hour on weekdays, and on Saturdays. No services operate on Sundays.
- 3.11 Route 724 runs from Harlow to Heathrow Airport, via Great Amwell, Ware, Hertford, Welwyn Garden City, Hatfield, St Albans, Watford, and Rickmansworth. There is 1 bus an hour on weekdays, Saturdays and on Sundays.
- 3.12 From the above it can therefore be seen that the area has access to local bus services with around 6 buses an hour within 400m of the site.
- 3.13 The local timetables are contained at Appendix C.

Public Transport - Rail

- 3.14 St Margarets Rail Station is located around 1.9km of the site and provides around 2 departures per hour in each direction on the Greater Anglia Railways line between London Liverpool Street and Hertford East.
- 3.15 Ware Rail Station is located circa 1.9km to the north of the site, and forms part of the same train line between London Liverpool Street and Hertford East.
- 3.16 A map showing the Greater Anglia Train network is contained in Appendix D.

Walking

- 3.17 The immediate pedestrian environment outside the site is typical of a suburban fringe and large village site, with a good quality c. 2.0m wide footway along Amwell Hill, past the site access.
- 3.18 The local area of the site along Amwell Hill includes street lighting, and includes drop kerb facilities at appropriate locations. A pedestrian crossing refuge is present near the Van Hage Gardening Centre, which is the main facility to the west of Amwell Hill.
- 3.19 The footway outside the site provides access to nearby local facilities, including to nearby Public Rights of Way ('PRoW') routes.
- 3.20 Nearby PRoWs including Bridleway Great Amwell 025, running off Walnut Tree Walk, across the road from the site, and to Footpath Great Amwell 016, running from near Church Path to the north of the site.
- 3.21 The above discussed PRoWs link the local area to nearby urban areas including Ware to the north-west and St Margarets to the south-east.

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3.22 A map showing these routes is contained at **Appendix E**.

Cycling

- 3.23 The local highway network within Great Amwell is mostly conducive to cycling, away from Amwell Hill, which is restricted to 40mph.
- 3.24 The nearest section of the National Cycling Network runs c. 700m east of the site, along the River Lee Navigation, and forms part of NCN61.
- 3.25 A map showing the local section of the NCN within the local context is contained at **Appendix F**.
- 3.26 Cyclestreets and other organisations offer online cycle journey planners available for determining suitable cycle routes from the site.
- 3.27 Details of the likely numbers of cyclists and their effect on the local network is covered in Section 5 which describes the impact of the development.

The Local Road Network

- 3.28 Amwell Hill (A1170) runs past the site access, linking north to south, connecting the southern parts of Ware with the A414 and the A10 via Amwell Roundabout and the Hailey Interchange.
- 3.29 Amwell Hill is c. 6.75m in width, and is restricted to 40mph.
- 3.30 Amwell Hill is also a bus route, as noted above.
- 3.31 Parking is generally not available on Amwell Hill, although localised areas of road widening are present in various locations locally.
- 3.32 The vast majority of dwellings nearby include off-street parking, and ample .landscaped and hard surfaced grounds to accommodate this requirement.

Summary

- 3.33 The site is therefore set to the east of Amwell Hill (A1170), between Church Path and Walnut Tree Walk, and c. 215m to the north of Van Hage Garden Centre. Ware Town Centre is located to the north of the site and is around 1.8km, or a 7-minute cycle, away. It has a wide range of shops and businesses that includes the day-to-day facilities that may need to be accessed by local residents.
- 3.34 There are existing bus stops located close to the site, outside the Van Hage Garden Centre on Amwell Hill. From these a total of 3 bus services can be boarded, these being the 310, 351, and the 724 GreenLine services. The area has access to local bus services with around 6 buses an hour within 400m of the site.
- 3.35 St Margarets Rail Station is located around 1.9km of the site and provides around 2 departures per hour in each direction on the Greater Anglia Railways line between London Liverpool Street and Hertford East. Similarly, Ware Rail Station is located circa 1.9km to the north of the site, and forms part of the same train line between London Liverpool Street and Hertford East.

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- 3.36 The immediate pedestrian environment outside the site is typical of a suburban fringe and large village site, with a good quality c. 2.0m wide footway along Amwell Hill, past the site access. The local area of the site along Amwell Hill includes street lighting, and includes drop kerb facilities at appropriate locations.
- 3.37 The nearest section of the National Cycling Network runs c. 700m east of the site, along the River Lee Navigation, and forms part of NCN61.
- 3.38 Amwell Hill (A1170) runs past the site access, linking north to south, connecting the southern parts of Ware with the A414 and the A10 via Amwell Roundabout and the Hailey Interchange. Amwell Hill is c. 6.75m in width, and is restricted to 40mph.

4 The Proposed Development

4.1 The proposed scheme is outlined within the following section, including a description of the proposal at hand, site access arrangement, as well as parking.

The Development Proposals

- 4.2 The proposals are for a single new dwelling, set within between Amwell Hill to the west, a dwelling known as 'High Trees' to the north, and the existing dwelling on 'Ravenscourt' to the south.
- 4.3 The proposed dwelling is designed to include dedicated bin and cycle storage areas, as well as an Electric Vehicle Charging Point, as standard.
- 4.4 The proposed dwelling is designed to include a two-car garage unit, which would provide plenty of additional storage space.
- 4.5 A Masterplan Layout for the development is contained at **Appendix B**.

Access and Parking

- 4.6 The proposed new unit is proposed to take access off Amwell Hill, in the form of a vehicular crossover, designed to be c. 4.0m in width. This will be detailed in line with HCC's Place and Movement guidance document.
- 4.7 Pedestrian and cycle access is proposed to be undertaken via the shared access onto Amwell Hill. The level of trips generated by such a development is predicted to be very low, and vehicles would be expected turn in and out of the site very slowly.
- 4.8 The proposed new access achieves the full visibility splay requirements of 120m from 2m behind the carriageway edge, in line with the Design Manual for Roads and Bridges ('DMRB') requirements.
- 4.9 A drawing showing the visibility splay in line with DMRB requirements is contained at **Appendix G**.
- 4.10 Access into and turning within the site has been tested through Swept Path Analysis, which shows that a large car can access and egress the site in a safe manner.
- 4.11 The Swept Path Analysis is contained at **Appendix H**.
- 4.12 The internal site arrangement is designed informally to allow two to three informal car parking spaces.
- 4.13 The site les outside the EHDC Zonal system, thereby the full requirements of the parking standards would be expected throughout the Amwell Hill area.
- 4.14 The proposed level of car parking provision is in line with the local parking standards for EHDC.



Servicing

- 4.15 It is proposed that servicing is undertaken in line with neighbouring dwellings on Amwell Hill
- 4.16 Residential refuse is likely to be collected by EHDC with alternate waste and recycling collections, as currently occurs in the area.
- 4.17 It is expected that with around three refuse collections on alternate weeks, all of which would be at known times (as per the local collection schedule), and which would usually only take several minutes at most to complete.
- 4.18 Similarly, there should also be sufficient opportunity for any occasional deliveries, such as furniture or white goods, to the dwelling.

Summary

- 4.19 The proposals are for a single new dwelling, set within between Amwell Hill to the west, a dwelling known as 'High Trees' to the north, and the existing dwelling on 'Ravenscourt' to the south.
- 4.20 The proposed dwelling is designed to include dedicated bin and cycle storage areas, as well as an Electric Vehicle Charging Point, as standard. The proposed dwelling is designed to include a two-car garage unit.
- 4.21 The proposed new unit is proposed to take access off Amwell Hill, in the form of a vehicular crossover. Pedestrian and cycle access is proposed to be undertaken via the shared access onto Amwell Hill.
- 4.22 The internal site arrangement is designed informally to allow two to three informal car parking spaces, which is in line with the local parking standards.
- 4.23 It is proposed that servicing is undertaken in line with neighbouring dwellings on Amwell Hill. Residential refuse is likely to be collected by EHDC with alternate waste and recycling collections, as currently occurs in the area.

5 Development Impact

- 5.1 The proposed development is that of a single dwelling.
- 5.2 The impacts to the local highway and the wider area generated by such a development are typically very small, and are considered to be negligible.
- 5.3 The site is set within a sustainable location, and is set to link directly into existing active travel networks nearby.
- 5.4 In this regard, a dwelling typically generates a handful of trips per day, which equates to one trip every two hours or so, during daytime.
- 5.5 Similarly, as the site includes on site car parking, it is not expected that off-street parking will ever be an issue at this site.
- 5.6 In summary therefore, the proposed development will generate negligible impacts on the local highway network and the wider area.

6 Summary and Conclusions

- 6.11 The internal site arrangement is designed informally to allow two to three informal car parking spaces, which is in line with the local parking standards.

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- 6.12 It is proposed that servicing is undertaken in line with neighbouring dwellings on Amwell Hill. Residential refuse is likely to be collected by EHDC with alternate waste and recycling collections, as currently occurs in the area.
- 6.13 The proposed development will generate negligible impacts on the local highway network and the wider area.

Conclusion

- 6.14 The proposed development is compliant with national and local policies, and supports national planning policy to focus residential development where this is needed and desired.
- 6.15 The scheme will generate negligible effects on the local highway network, and will support existing local networks and services through increase custom and a higher population density.
- 6.16 There are therefore no highways or transportation reason why the proposed development should not be granted planning consent.








Appendix: D - Rail Services






Appendix: E - PRoW Map






Appendix: F - Cycle Routes
