Details of the pre-application advice received

- The principle of development was deemed acceptable and was supported.

- The scale and size of the building raised concerns and a decrease by 1-storey was deemed to be acceptable.
- The site is located within a conservation area, therefore a Heritage Impact Assessment and a Design and Access Statement will be required.
- The proposed works have raised concerns over the ecological impact the development will have.

- Due to its close location to 63-65 Warminster Road, a Daylight/Sunlight Report is required to demonstrate the impacts it will have on neighbouring properties.

- Private and Communal spaces must be provided.

- The proposed development would not be supported with due to the loss of trees and its Biodiversity Net Loss. Off-site planting was not deemed as an acceptable solution, so changes to the design would be required to achieve a Biodiversity Net Gain.
- The Site was deemed to have little ecological value, but the loss of green space is deemed unacceptable. therefore, soft landscaping, tree planting and a green roof should be considered to mitigate this.
- Due to the proposed development being car-free, parking survey is required to understand the impact it will have on the surrounding roads.
- A Flood Risk Assessment is required, and SUDS should be incorporated in the scheme.
