**Proposal: An application submitted under Section 73 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 for a minor material amendment in connection with the planning permission dated 01/06/2021 (Reference: 21/1105/F) for Change of use of the first floor residential flat (Class C3) to dental practice rooms associated with the ground floor dental clinic (Class E) for a temporary period of two years to allow:**

**- Variation of condition 2 (temporary permission – 2 years)**

You should appeal within six months and you must use a form which you can get from the Planning Inspectorate at Chartroom, The Planning Inspectorate, Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6PN. This does not apply if your application has already been referred to the Secretary of State for the Environment.

**What we do with your information**
