Dear Steve Perry, Further to our telephone conversation this morning

regarding the Oak Trees in the car park behind numbers 38,40 & 42 Clarence Road Chesterfield S40 1LQ.

One of the trees has uprooted and is blocking the entrance to the car park and needs to be cut up and removed to allow access to the car park as there are three businesses which use the area on a daily basis.

The remaining three trees are in a poor condition, are covered in Ivy, and lean into the car park making them liable to uproot in high winds.

Looking at the tree which has come down it is apparent that the root system has been compromised in the past, probably when the access to the car park was constructed, making all suspect to the same fate.

Each tree is approx 12 metres high with dead wood in the canopy and low amenity value.

I would apply to take all the trees down to ground level as they will be a danger in the near future.
