

# Cabrilla Dogs

## Noise Management Plan

All dogs on site are highly trained and socialised with the owner's family + staff each day.

The dogs have a set daily routine and there is minimal stress to the animals that might lead to agitated barking or howling.

There are also minimal visitors to the property, resulting in significantly less noise than in larger kennels.

The following strategies will be implemented to minimise and manage the occurrence of dog noise at the kennel facility:

- The dogs will be exercised and socialised with all staff on a daily basis.
- The kennel building is fully insulated and natural vegetation screening has been planted to minimise noise escape from inside the kennel building.
- A stock of muzzles and barking collars are available in the kennels and used only if a noise problem arises.
- All dogs if not in the house will be confined to their individual kennels from 23:00 to 07:00 hours.
- The kennels will be securely locked and any stimulant that might disturb sleep removed.
- The dogs will not be disturbed during the night unless an emergency occurs.
- Family/staff members that live on site will attend to any excessive barking incident in a timely manner.
