**Description Of Proposed Development**: Proposed demolition of existing stables and storage barn and erection of garage block including ancillary garden store, workshop and home office

Location: North Rye House Donnington Moreton-In-Marsh Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 1 November 2023 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.

The development falls under Schedule 2 of the above regulations and is within a "sensitive area" because it falls within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as defined in Regulation 2, subparagraph (1) Interpretation.
